## Important Notes

- Gina prefers a natural growth patter while Ken likes a tidy look.
- Their detailed instructions emailed to MDG flipped upside down. The priority during the visit became the east property line, then the west property line, both shared with neighbors' sodded and irrigated lawns.
- Northern exposure with Sunshine Mimosa fell from the To Do list.

## General Conditions

Plants look happy.

## Weeding Rating

The weed rating from 1 to 5, is a 3 (high).

## Service Provided

- Find a balance between clients' conflicting directive
- Mostly damage control weeding and very little strategic weeding was performed.

## Good News

- Gardens seem healthy with happy plants

## Concerns

- Lots of Dollar weed along property line that requires root network extraction
- Over spraying causes excessive moist, therefore unwanted weeds
- Lots of mint with roots similar to Dollar weed, deep and horizontal.
- Clumps of grass from neighboring property encroaching in with inadequate root barrier. A 10" to 12" root barrier is recommended.
- Strategizing and the east side consumed most of the time. West side was not serviced as planned.

## Recommendations

Scarlett Salvia has many new plants/growths emerging in the north bed. May want to reduce the number in the future and consider reducing the size of the mint bed as well.
