General Condition

- Gallardia and Green Eyes in beds are blooming beautifully and very healthy
- Worms in the beds indicate healthy soil
- Abundance of many species of birds in the gardens even though four strangers were very present
- There is a lack of reseeding by wildflowers

Weed Rating

It is possible that the thick mulch has been a deterrent to weeds.

Service Provided

- Major pruning of trees, shrubs and muhly grass
- Light weeding in beds
- Cleaning up winter weary calamint
- Removing woody dune sunflowers

Good News

- Gallardia and Green Eyes in beds are blooming beautifully and very healthy

Concerns

There is a lack of reseeding by wildflowers.

Recommendations

- Tree and shrub maintenance twice a year
- An additional service to assess all wildflower beds, noting re-emerging wildflowers.
- Noting location and types of weeds
- Redistribute mulch that was started but not completed in this visit
- Add dune sunflowers to two beds, start with 3-4 one gallon pots each bed
