## General Condition

Healthy garden!

## Weeding Rating

Overall rating: 1/5

Front gardens: 2.5/5

## Service Provided

1. Clipping rear forest's pathway and along left side of property line
2. Trimmed Coral Bean lower branches
3. Removal of some non-native Firebushes
4. Weeding
5. Replaced metal stakes with wooden ones holding Weeping Yaupon Holly at front
6. Some raking to get pine bark back on garden beds
7. Cutback Scorpion Tails, Tropical Sages
8. Curbed five garden waste bags provided by client and a bundle of branches tied-up

## Good News

9. Lots of volunteers, wildlife visible such as birds, squirrels and butterflies. Soil is healthy, weed rating is low, native Scarlett Hibiscus doing particularly well

## Concerns

- Powdery mildew on a Wild Petunia (*Ruellia caroliniensis*), common during rainy season or when over-watered. Not to be concerned about though.
- The Mona Lavender (non-native test) seems to be struggling. Should be cutback to new growth or add more water.

## Recommendations

10. Edging of grass,
11. Honeysuckle needs to be tidied on garden beds
12. Rear wall needs weeding
13. Cut back the Mona Lavender
14. Client needs to purchase more bags
15. Compact soil around Weeping Yaupon Holly
16. Remove non-native firebush
17. CAREFULLY trim off dead branches of Calamint on the left back
